CCGC SCHOOL

Provides a safe and nurturing environment for children unable to find success in a mainstream public school classroom.

Small classrooms with a low staff-to-student ratio.

Wrap-around, in-house therapeutic support services.

Individualized services for every child, plus special programing, activities, and more.



OUTPATIENT COUNSELING AND NORTH STAR IOP

Group and individual counseling options to meet families' varying needs.

Outpatient counseling utilizes traditional talk therapy in addition to new evidence-based practices.

North Star Intensive Outpatient Program provides 6-8 weeks of individual, family, and group therapy every week day to help address serious challenges.
